



School District 64 International Education Refund Policy

Fees may be refunded as follows:

- A full refund, less application fee of \$300 and host family placement fee of \$350, if the student's application for a Study Permit is rejected by Canadian Immigration. A copy of the letter of rejection must be included with the request for a refund.
- 45% of tuition, if the student withdraws prior to the commencement of the Start Date as posted in Section 16 of the Letter of Acceptance;
- Zero refund of the tuition fee, if the student withdraws at any time between the commencement of studies (defined as the first day of classes) and the end of the first calendar month of the program.
- A refund of prepaid homestay and medical if medical has not been used to date.
