



School District 64 International Education Refund Policy 2020-2021 2021-2022

Fees may be refunded as follows:

- A full refund, less application fee of \$400 and host family placement fee of \$500, if the student's application for a Study Permit is rejected by Canadian Immigration. A copy of the letter of rejection must be included with the request for a refund.
- A full refund, less application fee of \$400 and host family placement fee of \$500, if a student is unable to travel due to travel restrictions, such as border closures due to pandemics or natural disasters. (Example would be COVID-19).
- 45% of tuition, if the student withdraws prior to the commencement of the Start Date as posted in Section 16 of the Letter of Acceptance;
- Zero refund of the tuition fee, if the student withdraws at any time between the commencement of studies (defined as the first day of classes) and the end of the first calendar month of the program.
- A refund of prepaid and one month's homestay
- A refund of any unused medical – only possible if medical has not been used to date.
